## 150 YEARS OF EXCELLENCE

Individual school houses have existed in Noblesville as far back as 1820, but the district of Noblesville Schools was born in 1869 with the formation of a school board and the hiring of the first superintendent. The community's goal at the time was building the first high school and "inaugurating a system of graded schools" in Noblesville.

While a lot has changed about Noblesville Schools over the last 150 years, the district's pursuit of academic excellence and love for its students have been constants.

To commemorate 150 years of excellence, Noblesville Schools has partnered with multiple community organizations for a year-long, community-wide celebration honoring the district's history and impact.

# CLASS OF 1970- 50 YEARS LATER

When most of us were born in 1952, Noblesville's population was approximately 6,700. At the time of our graduation in 1970, there were about 7,548 people living in our home town. Indiana data for 2019 listed 63,133 in Noblesville. Point being; our small town has grown significantly. Even if you live in Noblesville, the changes are dramatic. But for classmates who've been

away, it just doesn't resemble the town in our memories. Hopefully, with name tags attached, we'll recognize each other during our weekend reunion activities. In addition to celebrating our 50<sup>th</sup> year leaving NHS, the school system is commemorating 150 years of student education.

Many of our parents grew up in Noblesville or surrounding communities. Other families relocated to take advantage of the industry and business opportunities in central Indiana during the 50's and 60's. Our home town's small population supplied two facts for certain; news traveled faster by word of mouth than in the Ledger and someone always knew your parent. Our toys came from Blands hardware and new bicycles from Essig Brothers Western Auto. In primary grades, nearly everyone walked to school and home for lunch. On special occasions, you went uptown and had lunch at Wimpy's or the Sandwich Inn. During the weekends, we watched movies at the Diana or roller skated at the Rainbo. Summer meant the ABC Drive-In and the Forest Park pool opened. Gas was only 36 cents so all those trips around Jim Dandy were worth it. Who can forget our quick trips to Clancy's during lunch time in jr. high?

From our different grade schools, we became the class of '70 in junior high. Moving to NHS in September 1966 was a daunting yet exciting event. Getting lost was a real possibility in such a big building. Academics occupied an important aspect of our high school life. Freshman entering NHS anxiously awaited to discover if they needed a bug collection and had to keep those "quiz sheets" ready. Determining who taught what class or how fortunate one was being assigned a specific teacher

provided a path toward graduation. Some of us knew listening to or watching films of old World Series games was historical. How did Mr. Wolf AKA "The Sun God" know everything going on? Our first attempt at teamwork was building a homecoming float as freshman. "Snap, Crackle, Pop the Hornets" didn't make much noise. As sophomores, there

was no "Catapult to Victory". Finally, as juniors we got that float building down as "Baloo' Em off the Field" won first place. We repeated first place honors as seniors with "Nail Sheridan". Our hard work managing the Junior Booth culminated with a "Nautical New England" prom.

Friday nights we attended either a football or basketball game. Our senior year was the first for Swanson Field. The football team had a winning record. They were first in the Sagamore Conference, beat Sheridan on homecoming, and then put icing on the cake by defeating Carmel 22-20. Noblesville's first swim team was in 1970 while tennis started during our junior year. Regrettably, basketball just didn't work out for the class of '70 and Mr. Harper concluded his coaching career with a losing season. Our class finished high school two years prior to Title IX being enacted and this meant that many possible female athletes were kept out of sports participation.

On May 31, 1970, we said good-bye to NHS. Our paths have taken us to different locations, opportunities, and careers. We used to send letters or call. Now it's an e-mail or texts. We acquired meaningful relationships, married, divorced, married again, suffered loss, and had our own families. Along that way, far too many classmates were taken. Our goal this reunion is to remember: friends, school, simpler times in Noblesville and important events or people that shaped our lives. Sure there's Face Book. However, this reunion is about genuine engagement. "Truly great friends are hard to find, difficult to leave, and impossible to forget." (G. Randolph)

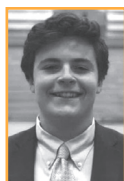

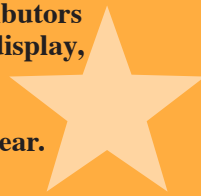
